By the present the company SURGIVAL CO S.A.U. informes that:

- It is possible to do a "Tomography" for the self-looking stems, bipolar heads and polyethylene cups It does not exists any type of incompatibility between the tmographycal technic (TAC) and the material used in the manufacturing of these products. The only problem can be the resolution of the image due to the lack of clarity, unless that you are provaided with the equipment of image processing.
- Regarding the 'Magnetic Resonance' (NMR) there are not studies published which says that a Magnetic Resonance can damage, being perjudicial or cause secondary effects to the patient.

 The only problems which can cause does not affect to the patient, but as it is written in our Postoperative Precautions:

There is a possibility of electromagnetic interference with certain rehabilitation systems based on the emission of high-frequency waves.

This product is detected by metal detection systems

According to some articles published regarding this matter it is written that only on ferromagnetics materials as the stainless steel it is not convenient the use of this technic because it can gives problems on the image resolution.
